Scholarship Application

Jean's Dream Scholarship is awarded annually during our *Beauty for Ashes Global Ministry Experience*. The Scholarship is for a deserving woman who is on her way to recovery from past hardships. The hardships can be the result of abuse, violence, addictions, abandonment or traumatic divorce, serious illness, or even homelessness. The Scholarship is based on nomination only. The nominator must write a compelling story as to why the individual feels that the woman they have selected should be granted the scholarship. The nominee, in addition to the above adversity, must fit the following criteria:

- Applicant must be a non-traditional female student. (Not directly out of high school.)
- Applicant must be registered or in the process of registration to an educational institution or an online accredited degree/certification program.
- Applicant must be in need of financial aid.
- Applicant must demonstrate a strong faith in God and be a person of good character.
- Applicant can be a recipient of a GED program.
- Applicant can be a student of a program that prepares the individual for various outcomes, including an entrepreneurial pursuit.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Nomination letter is not to be more than five hundred (500) words.
- Please print or type the application **clearly and completely. An incomplete application may disqualify the candidate for the scholarship.**
- The nominee should submit a 100-word essay stating your goals and objectives in pursuing this Degree/Certification. (Paper is attached.)
- Nominee is to include a transcript of courses completed, if applicable.

DEADLINES

All application materials must be received by March 3, 2017 for consideration. Recipients of the scholarship will be notified by March 20, 2017. The scholarship committee reserves the right to hold personal interviews prior to awarding scholarships.

AWARDING THE SCHOLARSHIP

The recipient must furnish to the ministry confirmation of enrollment in an acceptable institution or program of learning before the scholarship check will be mailed. It will be sent directly to the institution. Acceptable institutions include university, college, community college, vocational school or Entrepreneurial programs. If unsure whether your chosen institution qualifies, please inquire to the Board for Women's Ministries Scholarship Committee.
